1. Successful contractors must "Establish an internal training program, with annual updates, on how to manage completion of Form I-9 (Employment Eligibility Verification Form) and on how to detect the fraudulent use of documents in the I-9 process." p.. 10

2. "Work under this contract may involve access to sensitive information. For those contractor employees authorized access to sensitive information, the contractor shall ensure that these persons receive training concerning the protection and disclosure of sensitive information both during and after contract performance." p. 68
